



New York Mortgage Trust Declares Second Quarter 2010 Common Stock Dividend Of \$0.18 Per Share

NEW YORK, June 17, 2010 (GLOBE NEWSWIRE) -- New York Mortgage Trust, Inc. (Nasdaq:NYMT) ("NYMT" or the "Company") announced today that its Board of Directors declared on June 16, 2010 a cash dividend of \$0.18 per share on shares of its common stock for the quarter ended June 30, 2010. The dividend is payable on July 26, 2010 to common stockholders of record as of July 6, 2010.

In addition, the Board of Directors declared a dividend of \$0.50 per share on shares of its Series A Preferred Stock for the 2010 second quarter in accordance with the terms of the Series A Preferred Stock. The dividend will be payable on July 30, 2010 to stockholders of record on June 30, 2010.

Steven R. Mumma, the Company's Chief Executive Officer, commented: "Consistent with its investment strategy, the Company continues to seek higher-yielding credit sensitive investment opportunities to add to its investment portfolio. In connection with its pursuit of these opportunities and taking into account the current investment environment, the Company has maintained high levels of liquidity during the 2010 second quarter and expects to continue a defensive investment approach in the current environment."

New York Mortgage Trust, Inc. is a real estate investment trust (REIT) that acquires and manages primarily real estate-related assets, including mortgage-backed securities ("RMBS") issued by Fannie Mae or Freddie Mac (each an "Agency"), high credit quality residential adjustable rate mortgage ("ARM") loans, non-Agency RMBS, and to a lesser extent, certain other real-estate related and financial assets. As a REIT, the Company is not subject to federal income tax, provided that it distributes at least 90% of its REIT income to stockholders.
